

#### Cleaning/ Disinfecting

- To the extent tools and equipment must be shared, use a CDC approved sanitizing solution to wipe or spray tools between uses. Consult manufacturer recommendations for proper cleaning techniques and restrictions.
- Clean and disinfect portable jobsite toilets regularly. Keep hand sanitizer on hand. Frequently touched surfaces should be disinfected regularly.

#### GWHFH Construction Staff

- Wear masks and observe social distancing guidelines on site and during meetings, paying special attention when inside homes and equipment trailers.
- Where soap and water are not available, hand sanitizer should be in regular use.
- Report any safety and health concerns to on-site supervisor.
- Ensure that volunteers are following proper COVID-19 safety protocols.
- If you exhibit Coronavirus symptoms or come in to contact with someone who tests positive for the virus, notify Mark and Cheri immediately.

#### GWHFH Construction Volunteers

- Until such time as restrictions can safely be lifted, persons belonging to vulnerable groups (over 60, diabetes, chronic lung disease, immunocompromised, serious heart conditions, chronic kidney disease, liver disease, and severe obesity) are asked to stay home for their own health and safety.
- No more than 10 volunteers should be on-site at any time.
- Always wear protective masks and observe social distancing guidelines.
- Gloves should be worn while working. Hand sanitizer is less effective on grimy and oily skin.
- Please stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms of Coronavirus or have come into contact with someone who tests positive for the virus.
- The health and safety of our staff and volunteers comes first. If you have any concerns about health and safety protocols on-site, please speak with the construction supervisor.
