Dear Friends,

One of the joys of preparing an annual report is that it gives us a chance to look back and to be thankful for all that has been accomplished. The past year was filled with both opportunities and challenges. Some highlights were:

- **GWHFH’s partnership program with Jefferson High School, the Construction Pathway Program (CPP), is now in its third year. Jefferson students have helped build 13 Habitat homes to date. 83 students have completed the CPP, and the graduation rate is 100%! GWHFH has been invited by Habitat International to present on the program at the Global Affiliate Conference in March of 2019.**
- **5 families are in their new homes! 5 adults and 17 children have safe and stable housing, including 2 single mothers and 1 single father.**
